



ADMIXTURE LIMITED WARRANTY

Concure Systems warrants its product, the Concure Admixture, to be free from material defects and that the product conforms to its current applicable specifications of stopping moisture migration from the concrete itself or from a ground source for a period of ten years from the date of placement of concrete. This warranty is provided, if said product is installed according to and in compliance with Concure Systems recommendations and specifications. Concure Systems reserves the right to inspect and test any and all materials to determine the source of the problem. If damages occur to floor covering materials due to moisture migration through or out of the slab Concure Systems will repair the slab with a corrective sealer and replace or repair floor-covering materials with the same or a comparable product at manufacturer's discretion. Concure Systems makes no other warranty, expressed or implied and is not responsible for substandard concrete workmanship in finishing, cracks, control joints and expansion joints as a source of moisture migration or other types of concrete additives used. The sole and exclusive remedy of purchaser for any claim concerning this product, including, but not limited to, claims alleging breach of warranty, negligence, strict liability or otherwise, is the resealing of the concrete slab and replacement or repair of damaged floor covering materials, at the sole option of Concure Systems. All claims concerning this product shall be submitted in writing within ten years of placement of concrete. In no event shall Concure Systems be liable for any special, incidental, consequential or punitive damages, including loss of profit and use.

Warranty is enforced upon Concure Systems receiving the following information: Concrete mix design prior to placement of concrete, cement truck tickets filed, engineer evaluations and reports, confirmation of compliance with strict cement to water ratio guidelines by concrete supplier and installer.

Prior to installation of flooring, a rubber mat test (ASTM D-4263) must be performed according to the Resilient Flooring Institute Guidelines and the result to be registered with Concure Systems. All accounts must be paid in full prior to any warranty being issued or enforced.
